REVIEW OF PROGRESS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

As at 31 December 2021, the Trust's total assets stood at just under £1,000,000. Included in that figure is the Trust's investment portfolio which grew by approximately 16% to £860,000 and which contributed £26,000 to the Trust's total income. Income from all sources totalled £138,000, an increase compared to 2020.

The Trust made grants totalling £108,000 during the year (2020: £60,600); the principal recipients being St Mary the Virgin, St Mary in the Marsh (£14,900), St Eanswith, Brenzett (£13,800), St George, Ivychurch (£13,000), St Peter & St Paul, Dymchurch (£12,100), St Dunstan, Snargate (£11,500), St Mary, East Guldeford (£7,800), St Augustine, Brookland (£6,100) and All Saints, Lydd (£6,000), together with £15,600 for the creation of mosaics for four churches.

RESERVES POLICY

Recognising that the Trust's income is variable, the Council has adopted a policy of endeavouring to retain sufficient cash to ensure that the Trust's ongoing obligations are met. At the end of the year the Trust had a net cash balance of £114,000 (2020 - £97,000).
